UNPACKING

Carefully remove all components (see next page) from carton and inspect. If components are damaged or missing, do not use product, and contact your GF authorized distributor immediately.

INTENDED USE

The stethoscope is intended to facilitate the ability to hear internal sounds.




FEATURES

This instrument contains five interchangeable chestpieces — both adult and pediatric diaphragms, as well as three interchangeable bells (3/4", 1", and 1 3/8") — to facilitate the detection of high, medium, and low frequency sounds. Each diaphragm or bell has a specific purpose as illustrated and described.

The high sensitivities of all these combinations will enable the user to clearly discern low frequencies, high frequencies, and the faintest murmurs.

COMPONENT DESCRIPTION (SEE PICTURE BELOW)



Large Diaphragm

Is generally used to detect high-pitched heart, breath, and bowel sounds.

Small Diaphragm

Is designed to hear high-pitched pediatric heart sounds.

Adult (1 ³/8") Bell

Is designed to hear low and medium pitched sounds and murmurs. **Medium (1") Bell**

Concentrates on narrow spots such as between ribs or any other small places to detect low and medium pitched sounds and murmurs.

Infant (3/4") Bell

Best suits the examination of infants and small children to detect low and medium pitched heart sounds and murmurs.

Chestpiece Key

Allows installation and removal of diaphragms. Position key over metal disk and click into place. Turn counter-clockwise to remove or clockwise to install.

Eartips

Are provided in different sizes and materials for a customized fit.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

This dual-headed stethoscope, equipped with both large and small diaphragms fitted on a revolvable twin drum, is operational in two positions 180° apart. The drum contains a leak-free valve stem.

- 1. Carefully insert binaural eartips into ears.
- 2. Tap the diaphragm softly; this should produce sounds clearly. If you don't hear the tapping sound, rotate the head 180° until it clicks into place in the other operational position.
- 3. Tap again to be sure the instrument is correctly set for use.
- 4. Follow the same procedure when you convert from one chestpiece to another.

CARE, MAINTENANCE, AND CLEANING

- ▲ NOTICE: DO NOT subject the stethoscope to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight.
- ▲ NOTICE: DO NOT immerse in liquid, sterilize, or apply solvent or oil to the stethoscope.

To ensure the sound quality of your stethoscope:

Wipe stethoscope with a clean, soft, nonabrasive cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution, then dry with a clean, soft, nonabrasive cloth. Clean stethoscope thoroughly before each use. If disinfection is required, wipe the stethoscope with a 70% isopropyl alcohol solution.

Remove and clean eartips as needed with a damp cloth to prevent excessive cerumen or other foreign matter from entering the eartips and tubing. To remove, grasp eartips firmly and unscrew them from binaurals. Reinstall eartips immediately after cleaning.

SCOPE OF WARRANTY
